

Joplin as phono archiving front-end



Connect your turntable's output straight to the Joplin's input. No phono preamp is required. You may use an MC step-up or transformer if you wish.

Set Joplin's gain to adequate value for your cartridge. Set equalization to "RIAA" or whatever phono curve you may need for a certain record. You may want to set high-pass filter to 16Hz or 50Hz with warped records.



Connect the USB port of the Joplin to one of your computer's USB ports. Set Joplin as the preferred audio input device. Launch an audio acquisition application and begin archiving your LPs' contents on your computer.
